### **Center For Research And Education Of The Deaf and Hard of Hearing (CED)**

On May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2016, Center For Research And Education Of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (CED) welcomed the group of 8 visitors with hearing loss coming from England. Mr Robert was an aviation technician, Mr David and Mr Chris were architects, Mr Brian is a park worker. Mrs Melinda is a principal of a mainstreaming school, Mrs Joyce, Brenda, Rosalie were county officers. Especially, Mr Chris was also football referee for players with hearing loss. All of them had good and stable jobs, they are actually admirable and this is hope for Vietnamese people with hearing loss – we will do the great same things like them. All we should try together!

On May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016, Ms Duong Phuong Hanh, the director of CED shared to the students of Tourism Faculty, Ton Duc Thang University about the travelling needs of people with hearing loss and other activities relating to the current needs in Viet Nam. As being known, these students with their responsibility and concerns are researching this topic for serving Vietnamese with hearing loss to travel.
