On Feb 15th, 2016, The Center for Research and Education of Deaf and Hard of Hearing People (CED) resumed for work after two weeks of Tet holidays.

On Feb 23rd, 2016 Ms Duong Phuong Hanh – CED Director, welcomed Students of Social Work Faculty of University for Social Sciences and Humanities who visited CED for exploring CED' services supporting people with hearing loss.

On Feb 24th, 2016, Ms Duong Phuong Hanh - CED Director, met with Representatives of Habataku Organization together with Japanese and Vietnamese student teams at CED to find out social problems of people with hearing loss in Vietnam and solutions for those social issues. After that, on Feb 26th, 2016 Ms Duong Phuong Hanh participated in the session to assess students' ideas supporting people with hearing loss which brainstormed from the meeting, at Habataku office.

On Feb 25th, 2016 Representatives of Irish Aids Organization and LIN visited and worked with CED for understanding: (1) How would CED can develop as such 9 services as present starting up newly its organization from 2011; (2) What are CED's difficulties; (3) How would CED raise and grow its capital; (4) What are the most important things to develop a social enterprise; (5) Why would CED leader select this type of business? Why would CED leader obtain such capability and skill ... for this social work as present? Irish Aids Representatives like ideas for supporting and establishing CED models at local regions. CED hopes to cooperate with Irish Aids.

On Feb 28th, 2016, CED Representative discussed with Student Group of Australian International School about English Teaching Program for hard of hearing students who have been studying in CED. The English Program will be organized on every Saturday starting from Mar 5th, 2016 in two classes: English Grade 6 for 4 language skills: speaking, listening, reading, writing; and English fundamental grammar program with two skills: reading, writing.

On the same Feb 28th, 2016, CED organized a meeting for caption group and supporters team. The team shared about case studies supporting people with hearing loss. During the meeting, the experimental caption interpretation was performed./.
